Camp site: is available after 6:00 pm Friday June 20th. If you need to come earlier, call us @ (512) 601-1166 or (512) 665-8837

\$10.00 admission at the gate. Kids age 15 years and under are free: "The proceeds of this trailride go to the Friday night Camp out."

Trailride: Saturday June 21th Breakfast @ 6:00am, Ride Starts @ 9:30am SHARP. When we leave the camp site the property gate will be locked so make sure you are on time. We will ride to the Juneteenth Picnic Grounds for lunch in St. John Colony, then back to Dale. (About 15 miles total)

Sausage wrap back at the Camp site after the ride to send you on your way home with something warm in your belly.

Directions to Camp Site in Dale, Texas from Austin

1. Take US-183 South to Lockhart, Tex.
2. Turn Left at the first signal light FM-672 go 7 miles
3. At the intersection stop sign FM672/FM1854 turn right on FM 1854
4. Go about 1 mile at the bottom of the hill gate to the Camp Site is on the left.

Directions to Camp Site in Dale, Texas from Houston (South)

1. Take I10 west (San Antonio) to HWY 71 (LaGrange)
2. Continue on HWY 71 to Bastrop, Texas (you will see a Wal-Mart on your left and a HEB on your right)
3. Stay in the left lane continue on HWY 71 about 3 miles to FM 20 your Exit sign will be on your right (Lockhart 27 miles) just before you get to FM 20
4. Turn left on FM 20 continue for approximately 16 miles to Dale, Texas FM 1854
5. Turn right on FM1854 go about 4 miles to a stop sign
6. Turn left go about 2 miles at the bottom of the hill the gate to the Camp Site is on your right.

Directions to Camp Site in Dale, Texas from Houston (North)

1. Take 290 west (to Austin) to HWY 21 (Approx. 15 miles pass Giddings, Texas)
2. Turn left on HWY 21 to Bastrop continue on HWY 21 to HWY 95 intersection
3. Turn left on HWY 95 continue ½ a mile to HWY 71. Turn right on HWY 71. Continue on HWY 71 (you will see a Wal-Mart on your left and a HEB on your right)
4. Stay in the left lane and continue on HWY 71 about 3 miles to FM 20 Your Exit sign will be on your right (Lockhart 27 miles) just before you get to FM 20
5. Turn left on FM 20 continue for approximately 16 miles to FM 1854
6. Turn right on FM 1854 go about 4 miles to a stop sign.
7. Turn left go about 2 miles at the bottom of the hill the gate to the Camp Site is on your right

Directions to Camp Site in Dale, Texas from San Antonio

1. Take IH35 north to San Marcos
2. Exit 205 Luling/Lockhart Exit in San Marcos stay in your far right hand lane
3. Veer right onto HWY 80 continue on HWY 80
4. Turn left on FM142 to Lockhart continue on FM142 (when you get to Lockhart stay on FM 142 go thru 2 signal lights at the second signal light (is HWY 183))
5. At the second signal light turn left on US-183 north
6. At the next signal light turn right on FM 672 continue on FM 672 for 7 miles
7. At the intersection stop sign at FM 672/ FM1854 turn right on FM 1854
8. Go about a mile at the bottom of the hill the gate to Camp Site is on the left

Things You Need To Know

- Dale, Texas is a small, historically black community located in Caldwell County. No hard liquor is sold here. You can buy burgers, fish plates, sausage wraps, soda, ice, beer, wine coolers, gas and diesel at KQ General Store. KQ General Store is two miles from the camp site and is our first rest stop on the trailride.
- At the Camp Site please do not throw trash, cans or bottles in the pasture. Put them in the trash bags provided. The grounds must remain clean for the horses. **NO FIGHTING WILL BE TOLERATED.** You will be asked to leave. Please watch your language around the kids. Please follow the parking posse instructions. Do not empty your holding tanks in the pasture.
- The ride will start at 9:30 am sharp. Temperature is usually high 90s low 100s dress accordingly. The trailride route is thru narrow back country roads with little or no traffic. **FOR SAFETY MEASURES ALL RIDERS AND VEHICLES WILL OBEY THE TRAIL BOSS AND ALL HIS ROAD GUARDS AT ALL TIMES.**
A hay wagon and port a potty will be provided on the ride.
The picnic grounds will be setup for the horses and wagons.(fresh water for the horses, tie lines)
- The Juneteeth picnic grounds are church grounds please respect them. Please refrain from drinking alcohol on the ride. There will be TV and Press there to view us.
The deputy and Constable are driving in unmarked cars looking for Speeders and DUI so be careful.
